As of possible interest I am attaching a copy of a report which we have recently received from the American Consul at Southampton, England, relative to the market in that district for office pins.

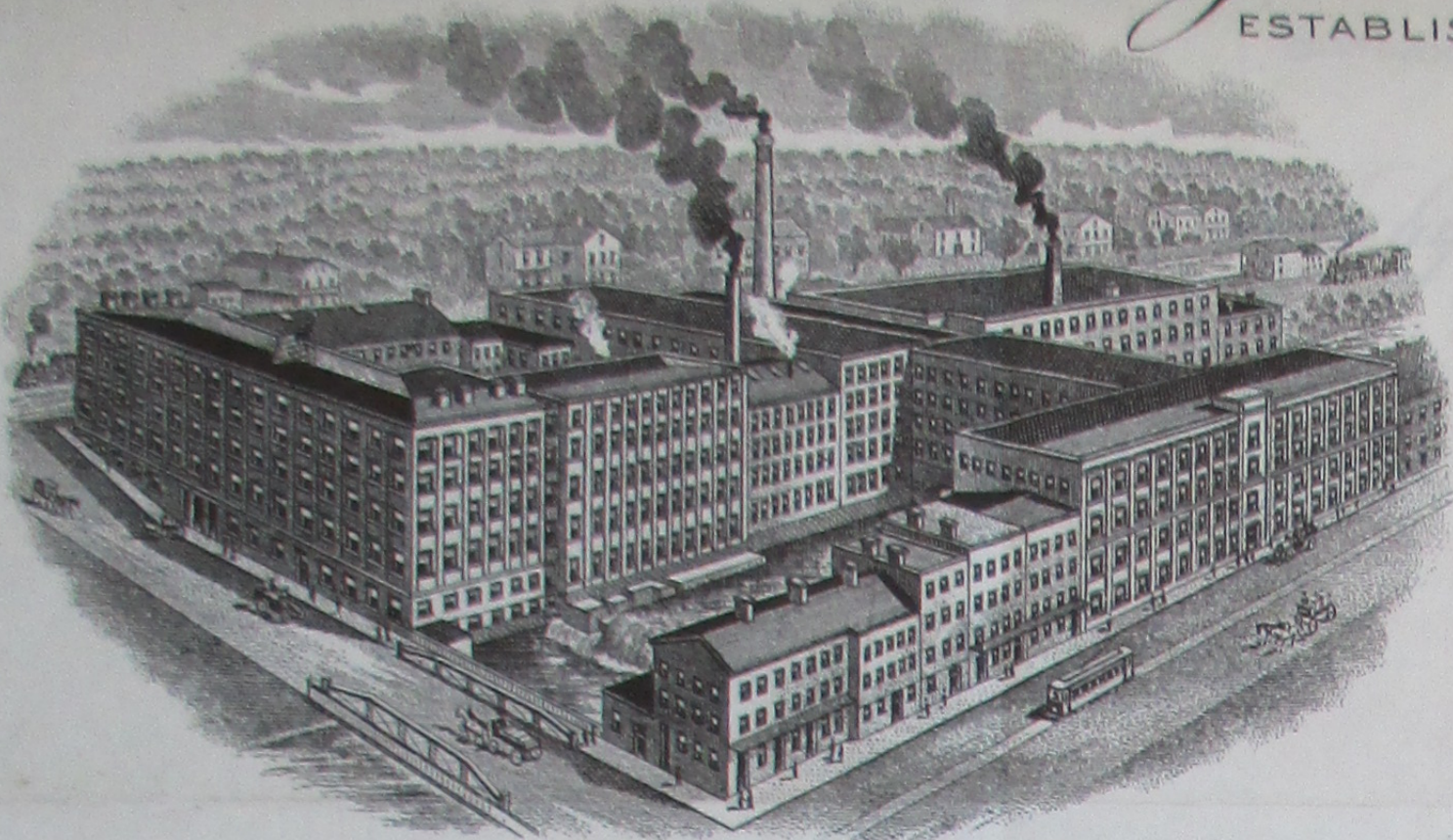
