

Under date of October 8 a cablegram was received from Trade Commissioner Baldwin, Melbourne, Australia, which reads as follows:

SOFT IR INKS INTERESTED IN THE FORMATION OF A COMPANY TO BOTTLE AND DISTRIBUTE COCA COLA FIRST IN VICTORIA AND SUBSEQUENTLY IN ALL AUSTRALIA UNDER EXCLUSIVE ARRANGEMENT STOP PARTIES HAVE SECURED ASSURANCE OF SUFFICIENT FINANCIAL BACKING FROM LOCAL CAPITALIST ENDORSED BY THE BANK OF AUSTRALASIA STOP ASCERTAIN IF COCA COLA COMPANY IS INTERESTED AND WILLING TO SEND A REPRESENTATIVE TO AUSTRALIA TO ARRANGE DETAILS IF INITIAL NEGOTIATIONS ARE SATISFACTORY STOP CABLE REPLY STOP URGENT
