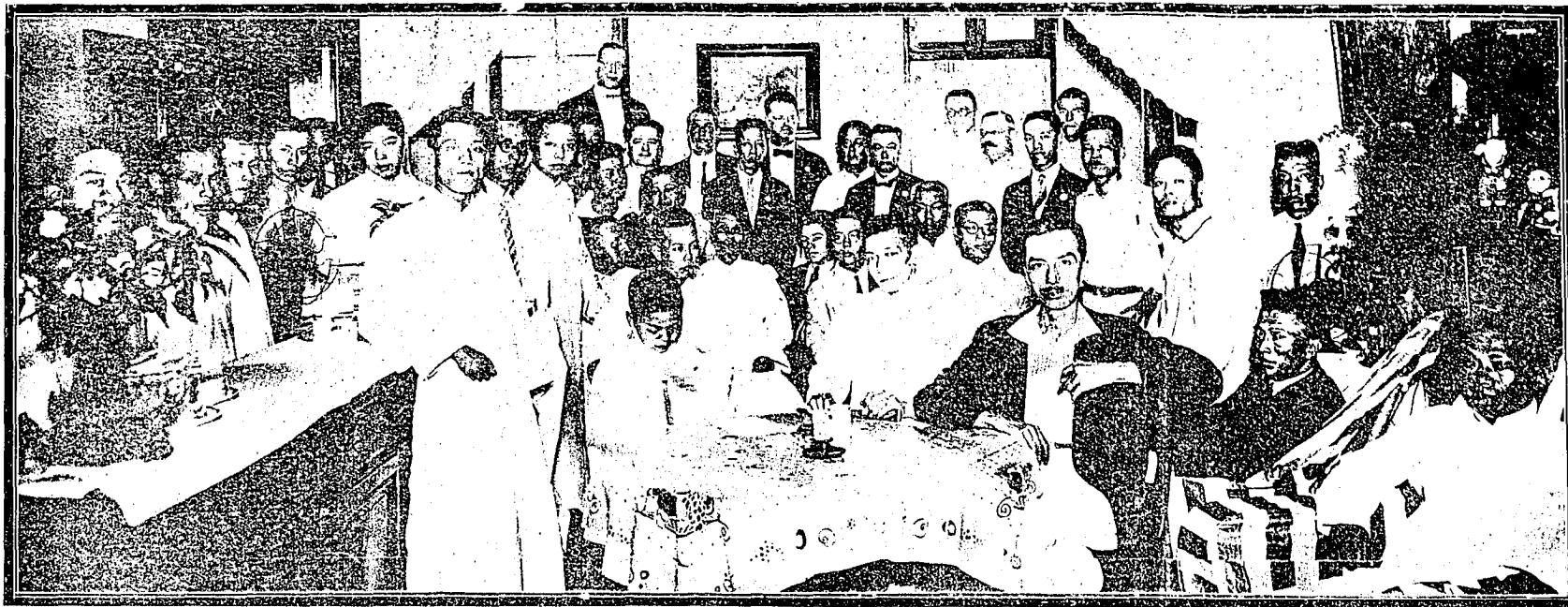

SOCIAL ASSOCIATION OF BUSINESS MEN INAUGURATED.—The new quarters of the Social Association of Business Men, 127 Szechuen Road, were formally opened Saturday week. The club was only recently organised and consists principally of Chinese and German business men, there being 25 Germans, 13 Chinese, 3 British, one Portuguese and one Swiss on the membership rolls. The purpose of the new club is to create a better spirit of fellowship among the Chinese consumers and the foreign exporters, according to Mr. Siow Choong-leng, President and proprietor of the new club.
