Dr. Crane's Advice to Run the Country as a Business Concern

Frank Crane, the cele-Dr. breated American writer, addressing the Rotary Club at the Astor House on Thursday said, .'The country must be run along business lines and not by politicians. Let the Rotary Club appoint 20 business men, send them to Pe-king and settle the troubles up there. I believe they can settle matters within six months and go home. The trouble with the politicians is that they would never go home, because politicians live by troubles while business men live by getting rid of troubles."

Senator Borah of Idaho he said, recently proposed that the United States Senate should appoint a commission of business men to meet with similar commissions from countries in Europe and settle the disturbed conditions in Europe. The proposition was submitted to Congress, but there were none to pass it-except the politicians who thrive on troubles. of this country business men should make a clean sweep to readjust political conditions. There might be 150 answers to the question of what China needs to-day, but it was quite safe to say she need not commit the same errors as those of other republics. They could start afresh here. They \mathbf{needed} prosidents, no flag-waving cannon shooting. They should leave out the peacock feathers, the pomp and dignity and hire a manager for the country just as they would for a factory.
