- CHANGSHA Delete XGOV and XGOH as both stations have been dismantled and removed by the Chinese Governmental authorities.
- CHUNGKING XGOS has been closed and is no longer operating.

CORRECTIONS

- CHUNGKING XGOA Frequency, wave length and power correct; add: Language used, Chinese and English; Time 2 - 4:20 and 17:30 to 23:00 Chungking Time. Operated by Central Broadcasting Administration. Daily International Broadcasts in various languages.
- XGOX CHANGE 11.9 M.C. 25.51 meters TO READ 15.2 M.C. and 19.73 M.

(Note: On September 5, 1939, the Central News Agency announced that Japanese aerial bombardments on August 28 and September 3, had damaged the Central Broadcasting Administration's broadcasting station at Chungking. Data is not yet available in Shanghai as to the extent of the damage or whether the station will be reconstructed. In the meantime Chinese Government broadcasts are being sent out over XPSA at Kweiyang, Kweichow Province, and on an emergency station at Kunming, Yunnan, A.V.S.)




