

Three Firms Summoned

Alleged Announcement Of Lottery

Two soft drink firms and one advertising agency were each summoned before Mr. B. J. Jennings at Central Court yesterday on six counts of unlawfully causing to be published an announcement in the local Press relating to a lottery.

Mr. Jennings listed September 9, 10 and 11 for hearing of the summons, commencing at 10 a.m.

The firms are Hongkong Soya Products Co., Ltd., of 28 Pottinger Street; Pepsi Cola International Ltd., of Fu House, fourth floor; and the China Commercial Advertising Agency (Hongkong), of Room 202 Great China House.

They are each charged that in conjunction with one another, they had caused to be published an announcement relating to lottery on May 21, 1958, in six local newspapers, namely, South China Morning Post Ltd., Hongkong Tiger Standard, Wah Kiu Yat Po, Sing Pao Yih Po, Kung Sheung Daily News and New Evening Post.

Mr. K. W. Lui, of Messrs Lo and Lo, appeared for the Hongkong Soya Products Co.

The China Commercial Advertising Agency and Pepsi Cola International Ltd. were

represented by Mr. P. J. Griffiths, of Messrs. Wilkinson and Grist.

Chief Inspector C. L. Smith prosecuted.
