DIRECTORATE OF THE PORT OF SHANGHAI AND WOOSUNG Regulations Governing Licences for Private Motor-cars.

1. The licences for private motor cars will be of two kinds as follows:

(a) Annual—A fee of \$30.00 to be paid in whole between July 1st and July 10th every year.

(b) Quarterly—A fee of \$10.00 per quarter to be paid between the 1st and the 10th of January, April, July and October.

2. The Fees should be paid to the Finance Department at Chapei (formerly Municipal Office of Chapei) or at the Municipal Office at Nantao. Applicants must fill in the blank forms prepared by the Directorate of the Port of Shanghai and Woosung. Licences will be issued when application is presented together with the required fees.

3. In addition to the licence the Directorate will issue an enameled disc which must be fixed in the front of the car so that it can be easily recognized.

4. For the convenience of the owners of the cars in the foreign settlements arrangement has been made with the S. N. R. to issue both Annual and quarterly licences on behalf of the Directorate. Application should be made at the Inquiry Office at the North Station.

5. From the 1st of July, 1926 no free licence shall be issued.

6. With the exception of the Ming-hong and the Liu-ho motor roads, cars with licences from the Directorate and bearing the proper disc will be permitted to pass through all the districts under the administration of the Directorate (including the Kiangwan and the Military Roads to Woosung) without further charge.
