VISITS NANKING

It is learnt that General Hsiung Shih-hui, Commissioner of the Shanghai and Woosung Gendarmerie, has gone to the National Capital on an important mission.

TAKES UP NEW POST

Mr. Nien Chen-yu, newly appointed Magistrate of Shanghai, took up his post yesterday morning.

WILL LEAVE SHANGHAI

Having recovered from his recent illness, Admiral Yang Hsu-chuang, Chairman of the Fukien Provincial Government, will leave Shanghai shortly to resume his office in Fochow.

DELIVERS ADDRESS

Mr. Yeh Kung-cho, at one time Minister of Communications of the defunct Peking Government, who is a distinguished scholar, now staying in Shanghai, has been requested to give an address on Chinese Poetry at Chi Nan University in Chengju this afternoon.

A big farewell banquet in honor of Mr. Len Tsuan, until recently Magistrate of this district, was held by a group of leading members of the local Kuomintang at Hung Far Lou (a Cantonese restaurant) in Shanghai yesterday noon.

ASSUMES OFFICE

Judge Liu Mei-chu, recently nominated Chief Procurator of the local District Court, has formally assumed his office in Shanghai.

RETURNS TO NANKING

After a flying visit to Shanghai, Dr. Wang Chung-hui, President of the Judicial Yuan of the National Government, returned to Nanking on the night of May 7.

TENDERS RESIGNATION

ORGANIZE TOURING PARTY

Messrs. Feng Ping-hun and Li Meng-seng, well known overseas Chinese in Shanghai, are making

preparations for organizing a touring party to travel through various countries in Asia by foot. They will first walk to the National Capital, then to Anhwei, Kiangsi, Hupeh, Hunan and Szechuan with Chengtu as their first point of destination.

GOES TO NINGPO

Shortly after his return from the National Capital, Mr. Yu Ya-ching, a prominent commercial leader of this city, departed from Shanghai for Ningpo day before yesterday.
