## **French Aviator Breaks All Speed Records**

ETAMPES, May 25.—(Havas).—Raymond Delmoite, French aviator, broke all corresponding world's records for speed yesterday when he flew 109 kilometers (63 miles) in 13 minutes, 54 seconds. He averaged 431.664 kilometers per hour, or 259.79 miles, thus bettering the former record of 428,138 kilometers (267.58 miles) per hour.
