

OPEL OBTAINS CLAUDE NEON EXHIBIT ROOM

Triangle Motors Now Has New German Cars For Demonstration

Opel four and six cylinder car and Blitz trucks, manufactured by the General Motors Corporation at the Adam Opel factories in Germany, will make their formal bow to Shanghai next month from a showroom at 310 Bubbling Well Road that is being taken over from the Claude Neon Lights.

Meanwhile, demonstration Opel Fours and Sixes are available at Triangle Motors, 99 Route Cardinal Mercier.

L. G. Zigalniksky, general manager of Triangle Motors, is organizing the Opel division of the company.

Mr. Zigalniksky describes the Opel line of automobiles as attractive, strong and economical cars. The Opel line of trucks, known as the Blitz, embraces two series, one a four and the other six. On obtaining the Opel and Blitz franchise last month, Triangle Motors placed an order for almost two dozen units which include various four and six cylinder Opel automobile models and Blitz light and heavy trucks.

FIAT CO. LOANS POLAND MILLION

NEW YORK, Jan. 16.—In exchange for a loan of one million dollars the Polish Government has given the Fiat Motor Co. of Italy concessions which may close the Polish market to foreign automobiles, according to reports. Under the concession to the Fiat company, these automobiles will pay considerably lower road tax than other cars, while tariff duties on foreign cars will be increased.
